#### **Police Arrest Suspect in Indecent Exposure Cases**

The Parker Police Department arrested 20 year-old Shamari James Scott (03/30/1998) twice in the last week on charges of Indecent Exposure and other charges.

On Wednesday, June 6 at approximately 10:30 a.m., police responded to a report of Indecent Exposure in the parking lot of 19600 Victorian Drive. Scott was identified and issued a summons charging him with Indecent Exposure.

Scott was arrested early Thursday morning, June 7, and charged with Criminal Trespass, Criminal Tampering, Criminal Mischief, Attempted Burglary, Theft, Harassment and additional Indecent Exposure charges. These incidents were reported in the Idyllwilde and Rowley Downs subdivision. Scott was transported to the Douglas County Jail where charges from the indecent exposure on June 6<sup>th</sup> were combined. Scott was later released on a Personal Recognizance (PR) Bond.

On Saturday, June 9, we received an indecent exposure report near the intersection of Canterbury Parkway and Canterbury Lane at 9:24 a.m. The victim gave a description of the suspect who was no longer on scene to the responding Officer. A few hours later, Scott was located and arrested at the Parker Days Festival and booked into the Douglas County Jail on additional charges of Indecent Exposure and Violation of Bail Bond Conditions.

At the time of this press release, Scott was still in custody in the Douglas County Jail with a \$10,000 bond.
